New York Citizens Audit PAC has formally served the New York State Attorney General Letitia James for redress of grievances as detailed in our Petition to Decertify the 2020 General Election in NYS. Our research uncovered shocking violations of the law at the NYS Board of Elections, exposing data discrepancies that call starkly into question the legitimacy of the results in the presidential race, as well as down ballot races all across the state.

For example, a discrepancy of over a quarter of a million votes in the reporting totals published by the Secretary of State, Board of Elections, and precincts. For example, 1.9M registrations in the state voter rolls that are missing from the corresponding county voter rolls. Over 300,000 false duplicate registrations for single voters, many of which were utilized nefariously to double vote, an outright felony.

Signers include over 2,000 residents of 15 New York State Counties. The Petition details over 30 grievances regarding our findings of election irregularities and irreconcilabilities, and the corresponding broken statutes in state and election law.

The counties included in today's filing are: Albany, Chautauqua, Dutchess, Erie, Monroe, Nassau, New York, Niagara, Onondaga, Orange, Putnam, Queens, Rochester, Suffolk, and Westchester

New York Citizens Audit is a team of concerned citizen volunteers working to restore integrity to the Empire State. By gathering and analyzing publicly available voter data, we have uncovered shocking revelations about our rigged election system. Based on our findings we are calling for the decertification of the entire New York State 2020 General Election, especially a minimum of 89 improperly certified New York State legislative races.

We seek to include and involve all New York State citizens in asserting every legal remedy within the New York State and United States constitutions to rectify the egregious violations of law in the New York State 2020 general election, including but not limited to proceedings in the Judicial, Executive and Legislative branches.

We must uphold our right under the law to free and fair elections, including but not limited to one lawful citizen- one registration- one vote, hand-counted paper ballots, and citizen involvement in conducting, controlling, managing, monitoring, and verifying every stage of the election process. This is the way to secure our inalienable rights to life, liberty, and the pursuit of happiness, and

the path to restoring our truthful identity as a Godly nation.
